Dear Parents/Carers,

We are always very pleased with the support that the children receive from home with their topic work, phonics, reading, spellings and learning facts such as times tables, thank you for this.

### School Website

#### **Enrichment Weeks**

This term we will be having two enrichment weeks, one in the first half term, the second in June. The reason for this being that we had to cancel the spring term enrichment week due to adverse weather, it is really annoying when the weather affects our plans!

## Statutory Assessments


