  - Writing - develop basic sentence writing skills using capital letters, full stops, question marks, exclamation marks and finger spaces using the stimulus of fiction and non-fiction books linked to science investigations relating to plants and animals.
  - Handwriting - develop a consistent style and size of writing
- Literacy activities relating to the story of Jack and the Beanstalk and Sophie's Snail which link to our work as super scientists.
